Kentucky Opera 27/28 75th Anniversary Season Brochure Request for Quote (RFQ) to review work. (application is free)

[Kentucky Opera](#) seeks local artists (Kentucky and Southern Indiana) to create production-specific images for our 75th Anniversary 2027-2028 Season. Kentucky Opera is the state opera of Kentucky and serves communities across the Commonwealth and southern Indiana. There are four mainstage productions each season, encompassing both traditional offerings like *La traviata* and new stories like *Scalia/Ginsburg*. In addition, we focus on engaging and strengthening our community through education programs for children and youth and concerts and gatherings that are free and open to the public. Our mission truly is ‘to spark discovery, joy, and connection.’

The 75th Anniversary Season celebrates not only Kentucky Opera’s history, but that of Louisville, Southern Indiana, and the entire state of Kentucky. A community that can support and shepherd not one, but multiple music and art organizations is rare. We want our 75th Anniversary Season artwork to reflect the community that has nurtured and supported us in all its diversity, history, and strength.

This RFQ is a request to review current and past work. Submissions will be reviewed by a juried panel and the selected artist(s) will be invited to submit a proposal.

The selected artist will be commissioned to create the image for the four main stage productions of the season. This image, ideally monographic with the ability to be broken down for marketing of individual productions, will be used in the season announcement, print materials, posters, and any merchandise.

Eligibility: Open to all artists 18 years of age and older. Must be local, meaning you live in Greater Louisville, i.e. the metropolitan area inclusive of Jefferson, Oldham, Shelby, Bullitt counties in Kentucky, and Clark, Floyd, Harrison, Scott counties in Indiana.

RFQ due date: July 24, 2026

Key dates:

- July 24, 2026 – RFQ deadline

- July 27-29, 2026 – Internal review of RFQs for eligibility
- July 30-August 4, 2026 – Jury review (jury comprised of Kentucky Opera, Louisville Visual Arts, and other local members of the arts community)
- August 5-7, 2026 – all applicants notified of status. Selected artist(s) invited to submit proposals for Kentucky Opera Season artwork commission.

To apply, please provide the following by **July 24, 2026 at 5:00PM** Eastern Daylight Savings Time:

- 4 artwork examples from within the last two years
- Curriculum vitae highlighting training, experience on commissions, and any exhibitions
